Cirrocumulus NV is a one-off disgorging after 22 months on tirage with specific dosage that delivers an elevated experience to the palate. We have used a percentage of bottled, matured reserve wine to give this cuvée a depth of complex yeast flavour and wonderful brioche aromas in the bouquet. The grapes for this special disgorging were hand harvested early with optimum sugar ripeness and flavour for Méthode Traditionelle.

Cirrocumulus is a special edition that is not to be repeated and definitely not to be missed.

Awatea is a key wine at Te Mata Estate and takes its name from the historic ship SS Awatea (meaning "Eye of the Dawn") that sailed the Auckland – Sydney – Wellington route in the late 1930s. The Awatea was requisitioned as a troop transport in WWII and was sunk off Algeria in 1942.

This is a truly unique, never before offered vertical of Awatea (1982-2022, excluding 1984 when the wine was not made).

The fruit is off low-cropping Clone 15 and Mendoza vines that vary between 15 and 20 years of age.

The aromas are complex and sweet, showing ripe stone-fruit and brioche. The palate is rich with well-integrated French oak providing fullness and structure that leads to a long, clean finish.

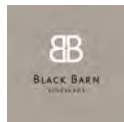
