After fermentation and fortification, the wine is recommended to age for two years in small oak barrels, staying true to the classic Vintage Port style.

Ts&Cs: Warren Gibson, Chief Winemaker, recommends ageing the wine in barrel for two years before bottling. If the purchaser is happy to follow this quidance, the wine will be bottled early 2027.
